AAS RULES AND REGULATIONS - LIVESTOCK SHOWING

- 1. All Entries must be accompanied by fees. Entries are non-refundable after 18 July 2025.
- 2. All particulars required in Entry Form must be fully stated and the exhibits must be those described on the form.
- 3. All exhibits must be bona-fide property of the exhibitor and in his/her possession at time of entry.
- 4. Dairy and Beef Judging will commence from 9.00am on Show day.
- 5. The Society may amalgamate or divide any classes as deemed necessary. Exhibitors will be notified on day of Show. No entry fees will be refunded should this occur. The Committee reserves the right to cancel any class if there are insufficient entries.
- 6. The decision of the judges shall be final as to merit. Objections to exhibits must be made in writing, signed by the objector and lodged with the Secretary one hour after the Class has been judged. Such objections shall be considered by the Appeals Committee, whose decision shall be final. A deposit of £5.00 must accompany the statement of objection which will be forfeited should the Committee consider the objection to be frivolous.
- 7. The Committee reserves the right to object to any entry or to remove any animal from the Show without incurring liability for compensation.
- 8. The Show Committee will not be in any way liable for any claim for compensation or otherwise, arising out of holding, abandonment, or alteration of date of the Show, nor for any other claim arising out of or connected with the Show.
- 9. Should any dispute arise for which a special rule is not provided, such matter in dispute shall be referred to the Appeals Committee, whose decision shall be final, and in no case can there be an appeal to law.
- 10. The exhibitor is responsible for the charge of his lot. Cattle to be secured by a halter. Exhibits to be distinguished by numbers only.
- 11. All persons entering the Show Grounds are subject to the direction of the Safety Officers, Stewards and Secretary. Any discourtesy by an owner or attendant will disqualify the animal from the adjudication or from taking a prize.
- 12. No person will be allowed to act as Steward in any Class in which he/she is a competitor.
- 13. No person or persons will be permitted to interfere in any way with the Judges when adjudicating. Such offences render the person or persons ineligible for prize or prizes.
- 14. Judges will use their own discretion as to soundness and have power to reject an unsound animal
- 15. No diseased animal can be admitted and should any animal manifest symptoms of disease during the exhibition, it must be immediately removed from the premises on an order being given to that effect by the Chief Steward.
- 16. No exhibitor shall wear a Steward's badge while leading an animal for adjudication in ring.
- 17. No rosettes to be worn on any animal while under adjudication in ring unless for challenge cups.
- 18. All cups won at the 2025 Show MUST be collected from the Trophy Office on Show day. A slip will be issued by the Steward to each cup winner to be produced at the time of collection. Owing to high costs, engraving is the responsibility of the winner. All cups won in previous years must be returned to the Show before or on Show morning to the Trophy Office.
- 19. In the event of the show ceasing to function, all Cups in connection with the Show become the property of the Society and must be returned to the Secretary before 1st July following Show at which it was won.
- 20. The Show Committee will not accept responsibility for any loss or damage/injury to exhibits, exhibitors, officials or spectators.
- 21. Gambling in any form will not be permitted in the Grounds.
- 22. All rules relating to the Show will be strictly observed and enforced.

INSPECTION AND PRODUCTION CLASSES Adjudication of Classes

Credit will be given for milk yield performances in addition to general conformation and type. The following particulars must be given fully on the Entry Form, otherwise entries cannot be accepted.

- (1) Name, colour, date of birth and date of last calving of cow.
- (2) Name of Register for which cow had qualified and has been accepted and her reference number therein.
- (3) Total weight of milk and butter-fat (in kgs) given in accepted lactation not exceeding 305 days duration.
- (4) Average butter-fat percentage in the lactation.
- (5) Dates of calving before and after lactation and date when lactation ended. The milk record on which points will be awarded must have been completed not earlier than 1st January, 2025. The allocation of points will be as follows:
 - (a) Milk 1 point for each 45 kg.
 - (b) Butter 1 point for each 3.5 kg.
 - (c) Maximum of 50 points for shape formation of udder and teats.
 - (d) Maximum of 100 points for general conformation, symmetry and size of body as judged on dual purpose lines.

An addition not exceeding 15% of the award under (a) may be when lactation is that of a heifer and commenced before she reached three years of age.

Antrim Show will host a Qualifier and the Final of the Thompson's / NISA Dairy Cow Championship

Thompson's / Northern Ireland Shows Association Dairy Cow Championship is being held this year at Antrim Show on Saturday 26 July 2025. All exhibitors wishing to qualify for this Championship must enter the name of their animal(s) and exhibitor details in their respective classes, at the qualifying show.

The 1st and 2nd placed exhibits in all Dairy Cow Classes at Antrim Show are eligible to go forward to the Thompson's Dairy Cow Qualifier, however if this does not include a "heifer in milk" (lactation 1) then the highest placed animal in this category should also go forward to the qualifier. Three animals will qualify per Show to include a maximum of 2 adult cows in milk (lactation 2+) and one heifer-in-milk cow (lactation 1).

No exhibitor may qualify more than **four** exhibits for the Championship final.

To maximise attendance of qualifying exhibits at the Championships, Stewards should enquire if it is the intention of the exhibitor to be present at Antrim Show on Saturday 26 July 2025 for the Championship final. In the event of qualified exhibitors not wishing to attend the Championship final, then the Judge will be asked to identify further qualifying animals.

Qualifying exhibitors who do not appear at the Championship final may be excluded from competing in NISA Championships in 2026, unless good reason is given for such non-appearance.

THOMPSON'S will present special rosettes to the exhibitors of qualifying animals at each qualifying show. Each animal forward at the Championship, which does not gain 1st to 6th place, will receive a Thompson's £50 Feed Voucher.

Animals placed 1st to 6th in the Championship will receive Prize Money as follows:

Champion - £500 plus sash Reserve Champion - £300 3rd Place - £200 4th Place - £150 5th Place - £100 6th Place - £50

Junior Champion - £300 Reserve Junior Champion - £150



Information from entry forms will be stored on a secure server. Results information, including photographs may be published (in printed form and online) both to the press, other societies and showing organisations and in the Society's publications. Information may be supplied to DEFRA, trading standards and veterinary advisors if requested by them. The making of an entry is irrevocable consent for the storage and disclosure of information in this way.

NPS Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part breds are not eligible for Mountain & Moorland Classes. To compete in Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony classes ponies must be registered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB, the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part-Breds are not eligible unless entered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern 5 - 7 August 2025. The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified. NPS/WTJ Insurance Brokers Ltd Home-Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards MUST be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeited.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a **Qualifying or Life** member of the NPS. A valid membership card

must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show 5 - 7 August 2025.

NPS/Talent Forte Recruitment British Isles Area Supreme Ridden Championship (BI-R)

The winning pony/horse from each of the ridden classes (excluding Leading Rein and First Ridden classes) held at the show is eligible to go forward to this championship. There are no specific registration criteria for ponies. The owner need not be an NPS member for the pony/horse to enter this competition or to qualify for the final but will have to become a Qualifying member to enter the final.

The Supreme Champion and Reserve Supreme Champion ponies at each NPS Area show qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship show. If the Supreme and/or Reserve Supreme have already qualified then the qualification may go to the third place, but no lower.

NPS/ Area 15 British Isles Area In Hand Championship (BI-IH)

The winning pony from each of the in-hand classes held at the show is eligible to go forward to this championship. There are no specific registration criteria for ponies. The owner need not be an NPS member for the pony/horse to enter this competition or to qualify for the final but will have to become a Qualifying member to enter the final. The Supreme Champion and Reserve Supreme Champion ponies at each NPS Area show qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship show. If the Supreme and/or Reserve Supreme have already qualified then the qualification may go to the third place, but no lower.

GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS

- In classes run under NPS Rules the ages of riders and handlers are all taken as at 1st January of the current year. The only exception is for Leading Rein classes where the child must be at least 3 years old on the day of the class.
- 2. Substitution. No substitution of exhibits is permitted.
- 3. Veterinary Examination. In all classes animals must be sound and healthy. No veterinary examination will be required, except when considered necessary by the judge, or in a protest being lodged. The owner of an animal rejected may, upon application in writing to the Secretary, be furnished with a copy of the veterinary certificate.

- 4. **Measurement**. All official height measurement schemes will be acceptable i.e. JMB, IPS/SJAI. All exhibits in classes restricted by a height may be measured, one half inch (1.3 cms) will be allowed for ordinary shoes.
- 5. **Prizes.** At the discretion of the Chairman of the Area, classes having less than three entries may be cancelled or amalgamated.
- 6. **Control**. Any animal not sufficiently under control shall be removed from the show ring immediately on request by the judge or steward. It is the owner's due diligence to ensure that ponies are not left unattended whilst tied to the side of trailers/lorries.
- 7. **Disclaimer.** It is a condition of acceptance of entries that neither the Area nor any of its officers, servants or assistants shall be in any way responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damages that may happen, from any cause or circumstance whatever, to exhibitors or their servants or assistants or other members of the public or to any animal or property, or to any vehicle brought into the show grounds, or on the premises used in conjunction with or arising out of, or attributable to the area's show or shows or to the conditions, regulations or byelaws prescribed by the area in relation thereto.
- 8. **Compliance with Rules.** Each exhibitor shall abide by, and accept as final the decision of the Judges, Referee, Chief Steward and Officials of the show who shall have the power in their absolute and uncontrolled discretion to withhold any cup or prize for the want of merit, lack of competition or otherwise in any class.
- 9. **Liability for Damages.** Each exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any consequential or other loss, injury or damage done to or occasioned by, or arising from any animal (including the spread or infection of contagious disease) or article exhibited or introduced to the showground by him or her and shall indemnify the area and its officials against all actions, proceedings, liabilities, claims, damages, cost and expenses in relation to or out of his/her entry or entries in the show.
- 10. **Protests**. Any member or exhibitor wishing to lodge a protest having reference to any person or exhibit shall do so in writing to the Honorary Secretary and shall at the same time deposit the sum of £100. If upon investigation by the members of the Show Committee the protest is not sustained the deposit will be forfeited to the funds of the area. All protests shall be delivered within one hour of the incident. The Committee's decision shall be final and binding.
- 11. **Change of Judges**. The Chairman of the Area reserves the right to change the Judges.
- 12. Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards/specifications MUST be worn by all Riders of all ages. All PAS 015; VG1; (BS) EN1384 (2017); ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; SNELL E2016; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards.
- 13. No person under the age of 14 years allowed leading a Stallion or Colt.
- 14. All persons 14 years and under must wear a CURRENT British Standard hard hat when showing in hand.
- 15. Dope Test. The Committee reserves the right to have any animal tested.
- 16. The Committee reserves the right to amalgamate or split any class.

- 17. All Exhibitors when entering at NPS Shows must abide by the rules as defined in the NPS Rule Book.
- 18. All stallions and colts 2 years old or over must hold a Stallion Licence, unless otherwise governed by their individual Breed Society. Ridden stallions (2 years old and over) MUST display a stallion bridle marker available from the NPS office or from any other society. In Hand Stallions are advised to wear a Stallion marker.
- 19. All riders must be 3 years old or over on the day of the show.
- 20. People leading ponies in Leading Rein Classes must be 16 years old or over.
- 21. All ponies must hold a valid equine passport in the name of the legal owner and must be shown upon request to the Show Secretary.
- 22. Anyone conducting themselves in a disorderly manner will be asked to leave the showgrounds.
- 23. Foals must be four weeks old or over on show day.
- 24. A standard cavesson noseband is the only type of noseband permitted in flat ridden classes.
- 25. Equine Influenza vaccinations are a compulsory minimum requirement for all ponies competing in NPS affiliated classes.
